Bio

Blood People started in Chicago in 2016 when a few friends decided to make loud, honest songs and see where it went. Founding members Aly Jados and Jeff Loehrke write music that hits somewhere between raw and melodic, heavy and human. With Ben Standage on bass, Ryan Thomas on drums, and the return of Shannon Burns (The Forecast) on harmonies, HERE is their most dynamic record yet, louder, softer, and weirder all at once. They have played Riot Fest (Chicago), Pouzzafest (Montreal), Wicker Park Fest, Midsommer Fest, and even the Stern Pinball Championship, sharing bills with a mix of legends and local heroes alike. Aly once joined Local H on stage at Soldier Field, where they

were opening for Metallica, to sing a cover of Motörhead's "(We Are) The Roadcrew," a true Chicago full-circle moment. Blood People may have played big stages, but they come alive in the smaller ones, where the volume, sweat, and connection hit hardest.

Why It Matters

In a time when so much feels synthetic, HERE is a reminder that real still hits harder. It's music played by people who mean it, no presets, no polish, no committee.
